



**The MPA DS9 IDPA Pistol meets the 2024 IDPA Rules Requirements for ESP and CO Divisions in the following manner:**

- **The Pistol, with the included magazines with tapered baseplate, fits into the IDPA test box measuring 8 ¾" x 6" x 1 5/8".**
- **The Pistol, when used in ESP Division, weighs below the 43 oz weight requirement. The pistol weighs 42.5 oz**
- **The Pistol, when used in the Carry Optics Division, weighs between 41.0 - 42.8 oz, depending on the weight of the optics plate. Non Co-Witness plates put the weight at 41.0 oz while Co-Witness plates put the weight at 42.8 oz (due to the fixed rear sight). Maximum weight in this division is 45.0 oz. Since most red dots weigh between 1.5-2.0 oz, the pistol should come under the weight requirements. Please verify the weight of your optic to ensure weight compliance. (Trijicon SRO weighs 1.64 oz as an example).**
- **The MPA DS9 IDPA does not come with a grip safety. This feature is not an option for this pistol. The rear beavertail is fixed and is not designed as a safety. Rule 8.1.7.4 in the IDPA 2024 Rule book states:**
  - **Disconnecting or disabling of safety devices including (but not limited to): manual safeties, firing pin, striker, and hammer blocking safeties is non Legal IDPA modification.**
  - **Since the Beavertail is not a safety and was never designed to be a safety, this rule does not apply to the MPA DS9 IDPA**
- **The MPA DS9 IDPA can come with a ported barrel that fits IDPA ESP and CO appendix A.2.3 ESP Permitted Modifications A.2.3.1 See Allowances and Restriction in 8.1.6 and 8.1.7 in the IDPA Rulebook A.2.3.2 Compensated and ported barrels that are incorporated into the firearm.**
